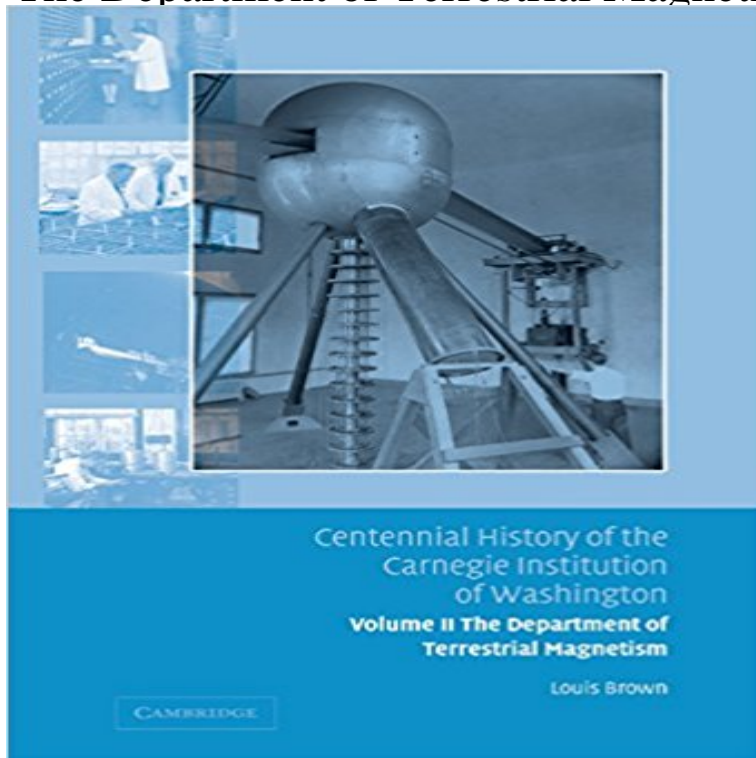


Centennial History of the Carnegie Institution of Washington: Volume 2, The Department of Terrestrial Magnetism
