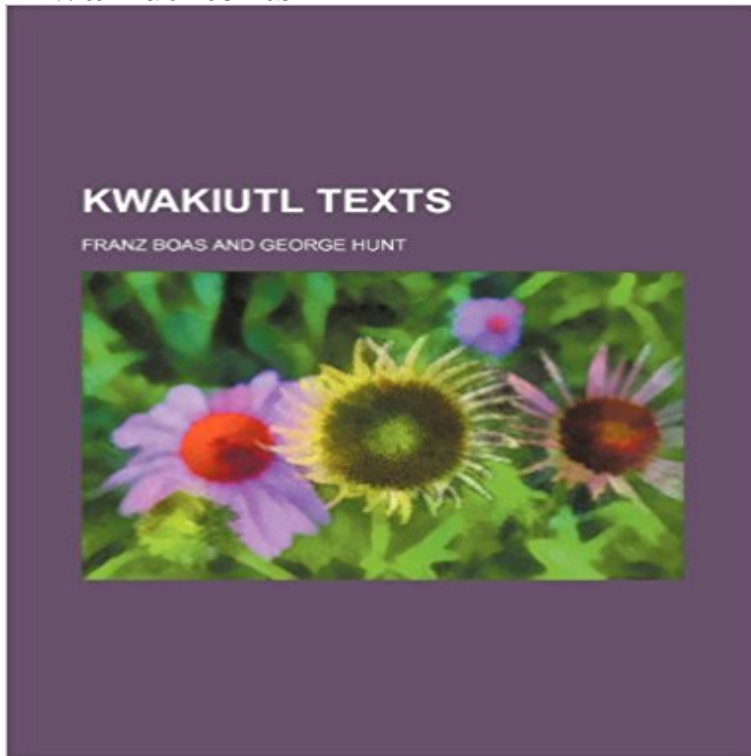


## Kwakiutl texts
