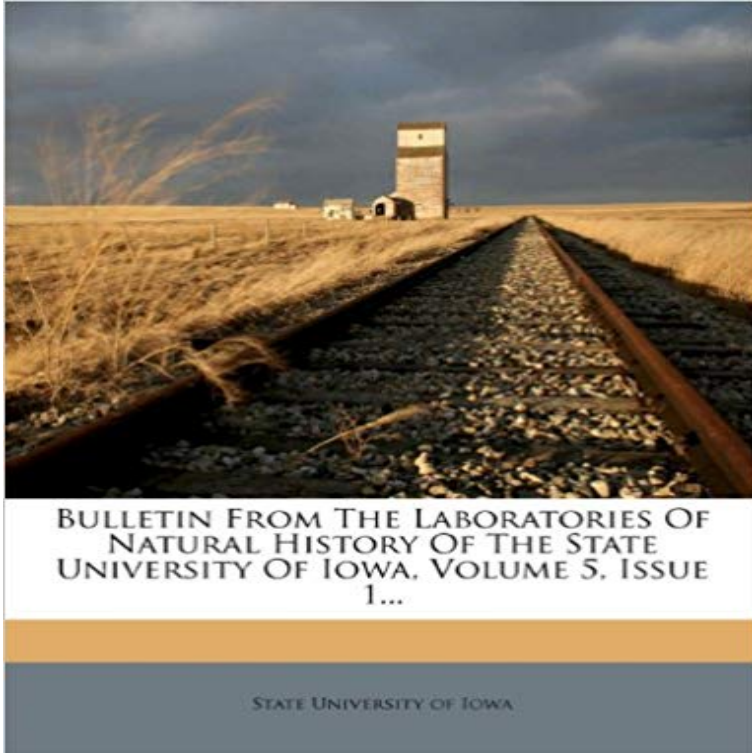


# Bulletin From The Laboratories Of Natural History Of The State University Of Iowa, Volume 5, Issue 1...
