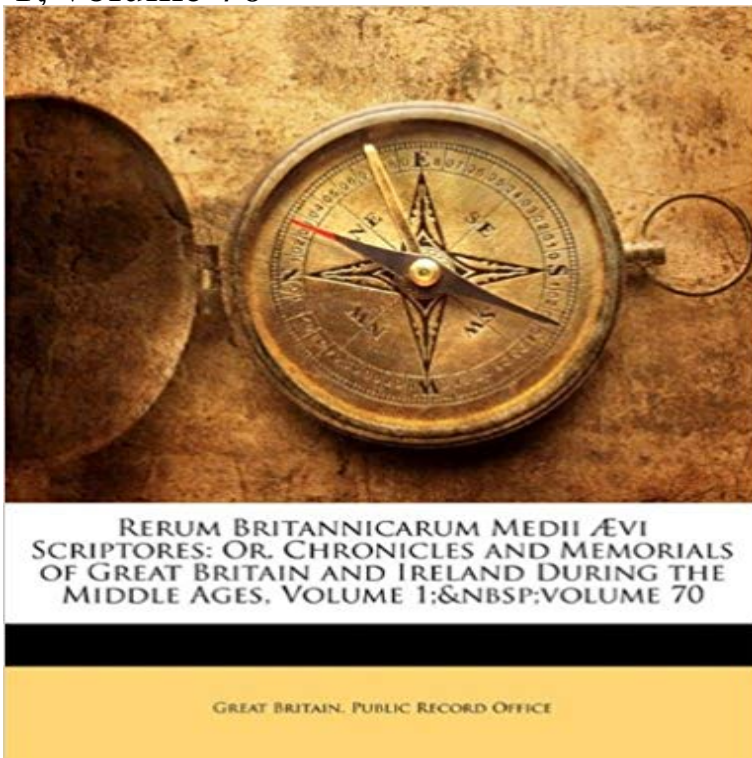

Oslac (fl. 966-975) is regarded as the first ealdorman (or earl) of York and its dependent. It is believed that he took over the position of ealdorman of York in 966, holding the position until Suibne mac Cinaeda (died 1034) was an eleventh-century ruler of the Gall Gaidheil, a population of mixed Scandinavian and Gaelic ethnicity. There is little known of Suibne as he is only attested in three sources that record the year of his death. He seems to have ruled in a region where Gall Gaidheil are known to have.
