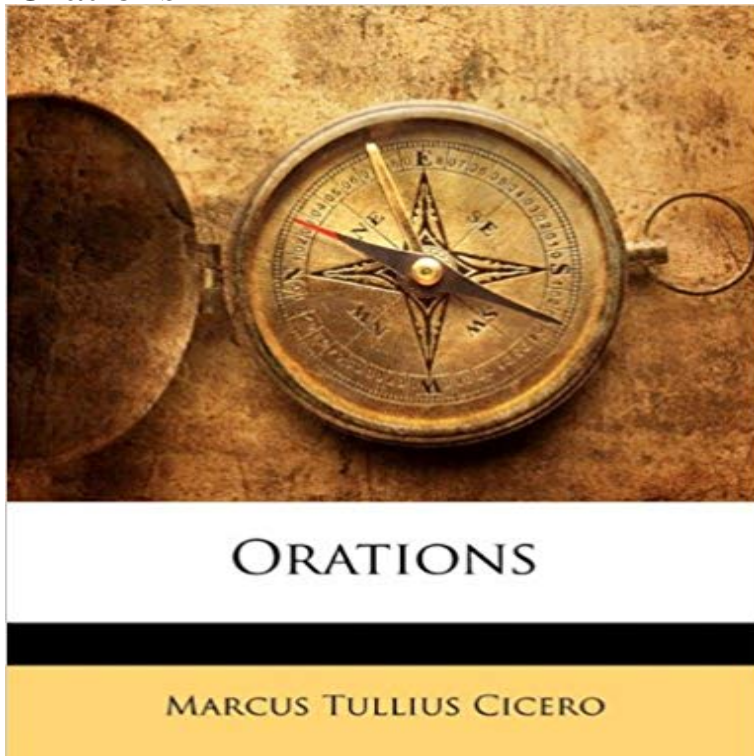


Orations
