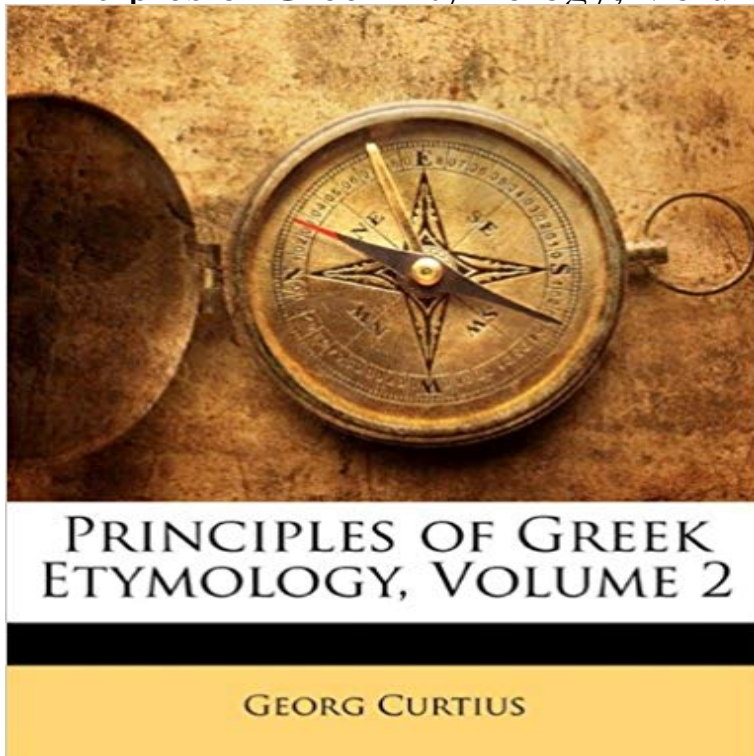


## Principles of Greek Etymology, Volume 2
