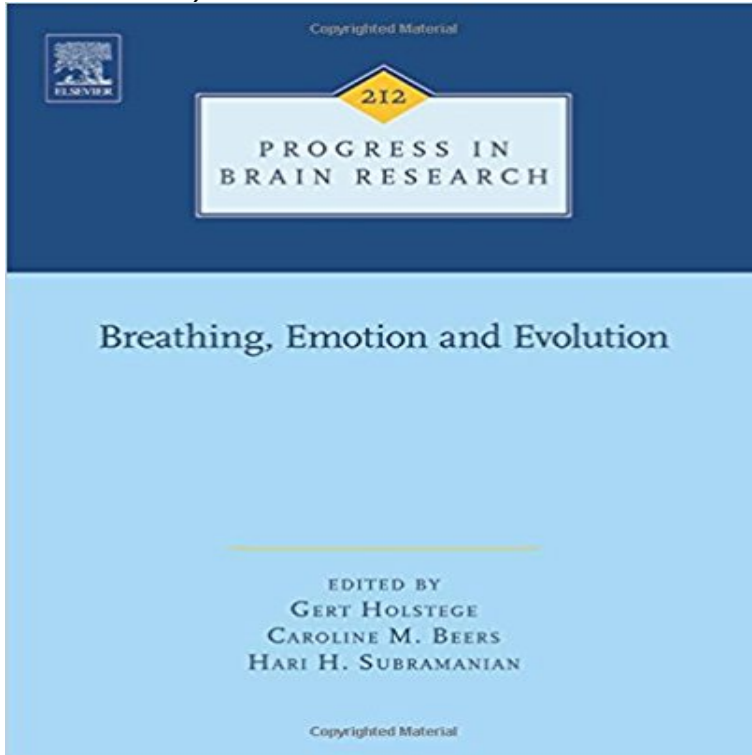


Breathing, Emotion and Evolution, Volume 212 (Progress in Brain Research)
