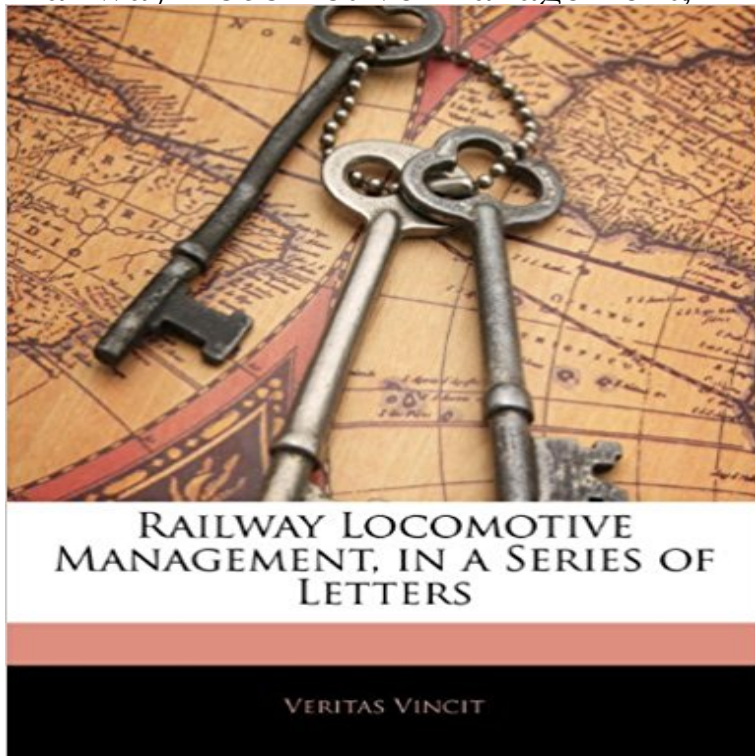


# Railway Locomotive Management, in a Series of Letters
