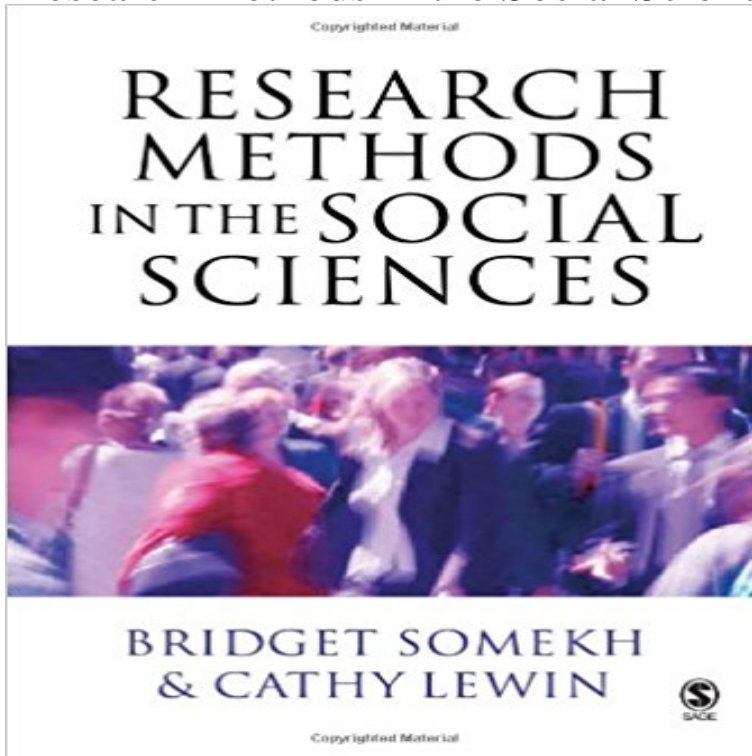


Research Methods in the Social Sciences
