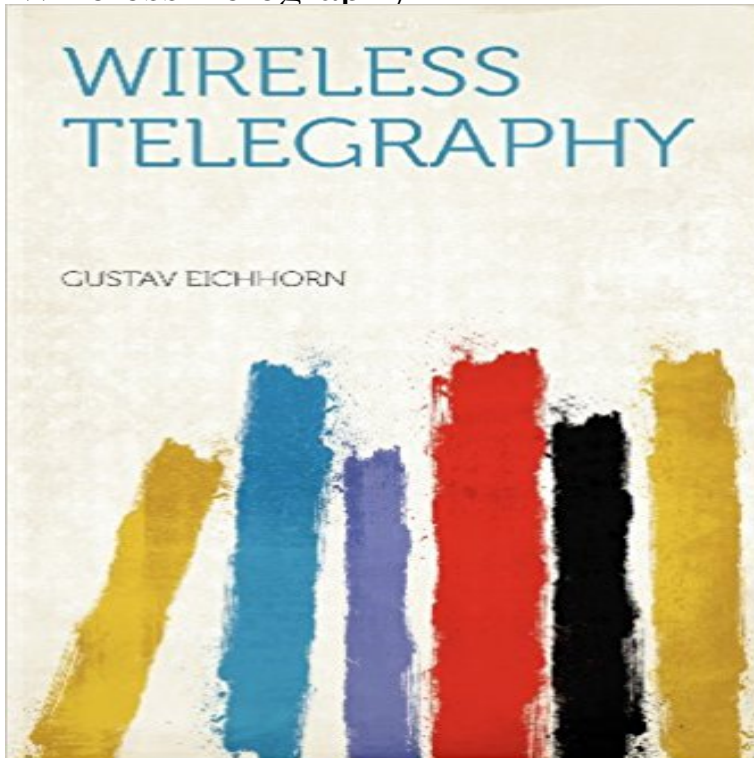


Wireless Telegraphy
